CHAIR'S REPORT – Don Erb

- Erb summarized his attendance at the Senior Leadership Retreat
 - Mostly Deans and VPs present
 - Focus on Enrollment, and Success in the morning, and Research, and Innovation in the afternoon.
 - Enrollment –up 4% in the middle for SUNY centers, could be better for international enrollment and transfers, but things are sustainable for now
 - We are slightly more male than female, this has been the case for quite some time.
 - Success –Improvements to the Ellicott Complex, Clark Gymnasium, and Student Union
 - Research –we need two things President Tripathi outlined:
 - We need more staff dedicated to research and information curators
 AND
 - Programs and or systems in place to support research
 - Tripathi said that they are going to put money into these places.
 - Innovation –upgrades to IT services, talk of a new Zoom feature that will summarize meetings using AI.

VICE-CHAIR'S REPORT – Virginia Stever

- Stever reported on her progress for the request for committee updates.
 - Awards Committee Reception 10/26, invite is out, but this is the same as a business retreat
 in Niagara Falls for some at the University.
 - Inclusion and Diversity Committee scheduling "Your Name Matters" and other staff development activities.
 - Lunch Bunch groups have started
 - Abbott has joined the Mentoring Subcommittee
- Milizia mentioned the Accessibility Tour of the Medical School, seemed well-attended, waiting on feedback and recommendations for the group.

SECRETARY'S REPORT – Tony Waleszczak

- Waleszczak reported on the quorum issue encountered at the first General Membership meeting.
 Quorum had been initially ruled, but after review, the meeting was 3 Senators short. New votes will need to be taken at the 11/2/23 General Membership meeting to ratify all the votes taken.
- Waleszczak outlined the numbers needed for the General Membership meetings to reach quorum.
- Parliamentarian Poole ruled that votes to ratify the meeting's proceedings may be taken either as a slate or individually dependent on the membership preference.
