Gibbons Family Chair in Neurosurgical Education Naming

Whereas	Kevin J. Gibbons, MD, FACS, FAANS, Janet Gibbons and UBMD Neurosurgery, Inc., have long been generous donors to, and active supporters of, the Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at the University at Buffalo; and
whereas	after graduating from UB's Neurosurgery Residency Program in 1993, Dr. Gibbons joined UB Neurosurgery as a faculty member, becoming an accomplished surgical educator and clinical researcher; and
whereas	Dr. Gibbons is considered an expert lecturer in neurosurgical education and patient management for residents and surgeons at the national level; and
whereas	Dr. Gibbons has been recognized for his exceptional accomplishments to his field, receiving honors including the 2007 Outstanding Citizen Award from the Buffalo News, the 2009 Kaleida Health Spirit Award from Kaleida Health and the 2012 Castle Connolly "Top Doctor" distinction; and
