## **Viola Diebold Olympic Suite Naming**

Whereas	Ms. Viola L. Diebold, was a longtime professor of physical education at the University at Buffalo; and
whereas	Ms. Diebold was passionate about providing opportunities for women in sports throughout her lifetime; and
whereas	she remained dedicated to UB as an emeritus faculty member; and
whereas	Ms. Diebold remembered UB through a generous estate gift intended to support women's intercollegiate athletics programs; and
whereas	her gift enabled the university to install artificial turf on the softball field, allowing the UB softball team to host home games that were not previously possible; be it therefore
resolved	that in deep appreciation for the philanthropic commitment of Ms. Viola Diebold, the UB Council hereby endorses the naming of the Viola Diebold Olympic Suite for volleyball and softball coaching staff in the Division of Athletics; and be it further
resolved	that this resolution be permanently entered into the records of the UB Council.

## **Brittany R. Murchie Sports Performance Center Naming**

## Rudy Bruner Center for Urban Excellence, the Rudy Bruner Chair in Urban Excellence and the Rudy Bruner Collection Naming

Whereas the Bruner Foundation, Inc., wishes to promote innovative thinking and

conversation about the role of design in cities; and

whereas it seeks to share the stories of creative and inspiring urban development to

increase understanding of the complex process of enabling beautiful, just and

resilient places; and

whereas the Bruner Foundation desires to build on the work of the Rudy Bruner Award

(RBA), initiated in 1985 as a national design award that has since recognized and documented 88 transformative places in the United States that have contributed to the economic, environmental and social vitality of their

communities; and

whereas the foundation has accumulated knowledge through the RBA—including 37

years of investigating urban development in America—and serves as a resource for research, learning, discussion, advocacy and inspiring fresh ideas and

solutions: and

whereas the Bruner Foundation wishes to offer a platform for ongoing inquiry and

exchange about the built environment and cities, and to create a resource for

those interested in urban development; and

whereas it desires to maintain an accessible, curated and active RBA Collection housed

within the University at Buffalo Libraries that will run programs according to principles of the RBA Program, and that will remain open to new learning

opportunities addressing its mission and vision; be it therefore

resolved that in deep appreciation for the Bruner Foundation's generosity, the UB Council

hereby endorses the naming of the Rudy Bruner Center for Urban Excellence, the Rudy Bruner Chair in Urban Excellence and the Rudy Bruner Collection;

and be it further

resolved that this recognition be forwarded to the State University of New York System

Administration for final review and approval by the SUNY Chancellor and the

SUNY Board of Trustees; and be it further

## Dr. Mario Rocci Chair in Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Dr. and Mrs. Mario Rocci Scholarship Naming

Whereas Mario L. Rocci Jr., BS '76, PhD '81, and Donna M. Rocci have long been

generous donors to, and active supporters of, the University at Buffalo School of

Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences; and

whereas Dr. Rocci has also generously given his time and talent to UB as a member of

the School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences' Dean's Advisory

Council; and

whereas in 2009, Dr. Rocci received the Willis G. Gregory Memorial Award for

personifying the ideals of service and integrity as an outstanding alumni

pharmacist; and

whereas upon earning his degree from UB, Dr. Rocci took a position at Thomas Jefferson

University in Philadelphia, where he was part of a team of clinical

pharmacologists conducting the first-in-man studies on drugs that have become therapeutic mainstays—including statins, ACE inhibitors and ulcer medications;

and

whereas Dr. Rocci helped establish and lead, as CEO, Prevalere Life Sciences, which was

later sold to ICON, and from which he retired after holding numerous prominent

positions; and

whereas Dr. Rocci and Mrs. Rocci, understanding the importance of financial support in

pursuit of one's higher education, have generously supported UB students in appreciation for the scholarship assistance Dr. Rocci himself received as a

pharmacy student; and

whereas Dr. Rocci and Mrs. Rocci gratefully acknowledge that the world-class education

he received at UB prepared him for a successful career with boundless

opportunities; be it therefore

resolved that in deep appreciation for the philanthropic commitments of Dr. Rocci and

Mrs. Rocci, the UB Council hereby endorses the naming of both the Dr. Mario Rocci Chair in Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Dr. and Mrs. Mario Rocci

Scholarship; and be it further
